## Dear 21<sup>st</sup> Century Families,

We would like to invite you to join us in attending our FREE 21<sup>st</sup> Century Kids of F.R.A.N.K.L.I.N. Summer Program beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> and running until August 2<sup>nd</sup>. The program will run from 11:30am-4:30pm Monday through Thursday and 8:30-5:00 on Fridays. We will

feed your child a healthy lunch from 11:30-12:00 and then they will join our 21<sup>st</sup> Century Staff for an afternoon filled with sun and fun! Transportation to the program in the morning will not be provided unless your child is a part of the Summer Learning Club. Parents will have to transport their children to the program for 11:30am. There will be a shuttle bus provided at the end of the day for the students to get transported home.

Thanks to a partnership with the Franklin County Children's Task Force and the Mt. Blue school district, there will be NO FEE for this summer program. This application is for children who are currently entering Kindergarten through those entering 5<sup>th</sup> grade in Cascade Brook School, Academy Hill School, G.D. Cushing School, and W.G. Mallett School. If your child is entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade, they will not be eligible for this program.

**Wilton Students:** Those students who attend Academy Hill and G.D. Cushing School should arrive at Kineowatha Park in Wilton at 11:30am for lunch. Thanks to a partnership with the Wilton Rec Department all students will be able to eat lunch for free. Parent pick up for Kineowatha students will be at 4:30pm at the park. There will also be a shuttle bus provided for those who are living in the Wilton area who need transportation home.

**Farmington Students:** Those students who attend Mallett and Cascade Brook Schools will arrive at Mallett School at 11:30am. We will be doing many fun, outdoor activities at this facility including daily swimming trips. Parent pick up for Mallett students will be at 4:30pm at Mallett Elementary. There will also be a shuttle bus provided for those students who are living in the Farmington area.

## What do we do?

- **Dates** Summer programming runs Monday through Friday from **July 1<sup>st</sup> through August 2<sup>nd</sup>** starting at 11:30am until 4:30pm. Friday's will be "Field Trip Friday's" as we will be exploring the area and all it has to offer (Friday hours are 8:30-5:00)! Transportation to and from the school will not be provided on Field Trip Friday's. We will not have programming on the **4<sup>th</sup> of July**.
- **Academic enrichment** Don't let the summer months escape you! Research shows that over summer break, the average student loses half a year of reading grade level. Not in our program! Students will be challenged with fun and exciting academic enrichment from skilled professionals.
- **S.T.E.M.** Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. Science is fun! Your child will have the opportunity to engage in hands-on learning in a way that's designed to make them want to come back day after day. Lots of excitement!!!
- **Kid Friendly Fun!** Your child will be swimming daily in a supervised and safe environment by certified lifeguards (they will need their suit every day)!
